# JIM KRAMER NEEDS YOUR HELP

This will be Jim Kramer's first time as Cursillo Chair, and for part of the weekend he must be away at training for his new job. Your help is needed in setting up and tearing down for the women's weekend. We will begin by loading our truck on Wednes-

day, January 17th starting at 5pm at Omni Manor Warehouse on Vestal Road, then moving to Mount Carmel.

Tear down is immediately after closing. Please help!

How many of you, after answering several questions by an "electronic person," finally shout into the phone: "I want to speak to a HUMAN!"

Communication today has become very impersonal. Many businesses and organizations have implemented the use of "impersonal" contact as opposed to personal contact.

Of all the tools that the Cursillo movement employs, it can be said that the single most important technique that we have at our disposal is personal contact. We should constantly make use of this tool on a one-to-one basis in the Pre-Cursillo, on the weekend, and especially in the Post Cursillo.

We will cover each one of these topics over the course of three newsletters. In this newsletter, we will discuss Pre-Cursillo.

### PRE-CURSILLO

The seriousness of sponsoring a candidate for the 3 day weekend has become diluted. Most candidates have been asked to attend the weekend, signed up and then just waited for the invitation to come to them in the mail. They're told what a great weekend they'll have... good food... a lot of fun. Most are poorly prepared for what they will experience during their Cursillo.

You should know your candidate and explain the weekend to them thoroughly. There are no secrets in Cursillo. Explain what will occur and what will be expected of them as far as participation. Share your faith journey with them, so that they will anticipate the same joy of being part of a faith community.

The candidate should be properly prepared beforehand, not kept in ignorance. Don't allow a person to go into the three days unaware of what Cursillo is and what it offers. Bring them to a group reunion... to an Ultreya... introduce them to other Cursillistas. Visit with them if possible. If that's not possible, then call them on the phone. Tell them about the requested donation... don't let them be surprised. When the invitations go out, contact them immediately, and encourage them to return their response as soon as possible. Arrange to pick them up and drive them to the weekend facility.

Stay in close personal contact with your candidate starting from the time you approach him/her about Cursillo, until you drop them off for the weekend. Answer their questions honestly, encourage them and let them know that you are praying for them. Talk to them about your relationship with Jesus. Make a friend... Be a friend... Bring your friend to Christ through personal contact.
