PERSONAL CONTACT: THE THREE DAY WEEKEND (PART 2 OF 3) BY LINDA SUSANY

One of the most rewarding and spiritual actions in the Cursillo Movement is being on a weekend team. Whatever the position, to have the opportunity to witness the working of the Holy Spirit within both the participants and the team members is both a very humbling and moving experience. Team members share their lives in Christ as speakers... Team members share their gifts of music... Team members share their gifts of service as guides and sacristans... and team members share their gifts of leadership.

But, as team members, do we share our gift of time? Time to learn the name of each person on the weekend? Time to sit and speak to each of the candidates about their lives? Time to laugh with them... and time to share of faith journey with them?

One of the most important aspects of personal contact is <u>presence</u>. Are you present to that person speaking to you... or is your mind someplace else?

Another aspect is <u>touch</u>. Taking someone's hand or giving them a hug when needed. Yet another aspect is <u>body language</u>. Sometimes the way you sit, stand or move can indicate your level of interest in what a person is conveying to you.

Lastly, we should consider <u>eye contact</u>. When you speak to someone, look at them eye to eye. Don't let your eyes wander around the room. That's a signal that you aren't interested in what the other person is sharing.

Make an effort to sit with someone different at each meal, and during each liturgy. Try to seek out someone that seems to be a little nervous or alone. Ask about their family or their job. Be aware of anyone who may be troubled, and if necessary, direct them to speak to the Spiritual Directors of the weekend. Laugh with them, cry with them and most importantly, pray with them.

Working as a team member on a Cursillo weekend is one of the most intimate experiences you may ever have. You have taken on a great responsibility... that of touching another person's soul. Take this responsibility seriously. How you interact or don't interact can make a difference in the spiritual life of an individual.

Remember, when you say "yes" to being a member of a Cursillo team... you are saying "yes" to Jesus when He called you to "follow me."
