

## Positions Opening on the Secretariat

Two Secretariat positions need to be filled: Lay Director and School of Leaders

I have served as Lay Director for three years, and **my term is now coming to a close.** As such, we are seeking for an individual that would be interested in holding this position. The new title will be **Lay Coordinator**.

<u>The Duties are</u>: Preside over Secretariat Meetings and set the agenda for them. Responsible for securing the facility for Weekends. The Lay Coordinator may only cast a vote in a tie-breaker situation. Stay in contact with the Region III Coordinator and attend all meetings of Region III. The Lay Director shall meet with the Bishop once a year. The Lay Coordinator shall give the history of the Cursillo Movement to new Cursillistas.

<u>The requirements are</u>: A Cursillista that is an member of a group reunion, living the Cursillo method, that has worked on a Cursillo weekend, and has previously served as a Rector or member of the Secretariat. Must be able to attend Secretariat meetings and attend Ultreya and School of Leaders.

### School of Leaders Coordinator

<u>The Duties</u> of this position are: Responsible for preparing and directing all activities related to the School of Leaders including providing formation for Cursillo Leaders, working with other sections, preparing the Pastoral Plan (Mission Statement). The School of Leaders Coordinator shall bring all recommendations from the School of Leaders to the Secretariat. The School of Leaders Coordinator shall appoint and oversee all committees and its members under this section. The School of Leaders Coordinator shall report on this section at Secretariat meetings.

<u>The requirements</u> for this position are: Must have worked on one team, be in a group reunion, must live the Cursillo method, attend Ultreya, attend School of Leaders regularly, must be able to attend Secretariat meetings.

I'm asking each of you now, wherever you are in your journey, whatever weekend you made— give serious thought about making Cursillo your main apostolate for a few years. Please pray about these positions, and if the Lord is calling you to step up, or you know someone that would be a great fit for either of these roles please let us know.

To nominate yourself or someone else for this position, please contact any member of the Secretariat. Their names and contact information can be found on the first page of this newsletter in the column on the left.

Also continue to pray for our Cursillo movement, the Catholic Church, for our hierarchy, for Bishop Bonnar, for our priests, deacons and religious. Most especially, please pray for peace in our land.

## YOUNGSTOWN CURSILLO SPONSOR GUIDELINES Make a friend. Be a friend. Bring your friend to Christ.

The Cursillo is a method for living, sharing and spreading Christianity. For this method to be effective, there are specific requirements that must be met. Therefore, sponsorship is a serious responsibility. Before you fill out an application, consider these two questions:

Will my candidate both benefit from the weekend AND be faithful to the expectations of the Fourth Day?

Is my candidate capable of and likely to use the tools of Group Reunion, Ultreya and spiritual direction to persevere in his/her Fourth Day?

In selecting a candidate, seek out individuals who would exert a positive influence in their environments. The ideal candidate isn't necessarily active in his/her parish already. Consider potential candidates who express a deep desire and hunger for spiritual growth and contentment, and who are currently living their Catholic faith to the best of their ability.

### Other guidelines to follow when selecting a candidate:

If you have been an active Cursillista for less than one year, please ask either your sponsor or an experienced Cursillista to co-sponsor your candidate. Obtain permission from the Pre-Cursillo chairperson and/or Lay Director to sponsor more than two candidates for the same weekend. Seek out the advice of the Youngstown Cursillo Spiritual Director and/or your candidate's Parish Priest if he/she has experienced any of the following in the past two years:

- Divorce or separation
- Death in the immediate family
- Treatment of any kind for emotional or mental issues
- Rehabilitation or a recovery program for drug, alcohol or other addition
- Serious legal issues

#### As a sponsor, your responsibilities before, during and after the Cursillo weekend are as follows:

- Explain the Cursillo as a short course in Christianity, as well as the expectations of the 4th day.
- Bring your candidate to your Group Reunion or to Ultreya prior to the weekend.
- Tell your candidate that the \$100 cost is a suggested donation and should not be a deterrent.
- Complete the application **WITH** your candidate. Complete the Sponsor Confidential Sheet on your own and submit both forms to your Parish Representative or the Pre-Cursillo Chairperson.. If at all possible, fill out both spouse applications simultaneously for all married candidates.
- Provide transportation for your candidate to and from the Cursillo weekend. This is very important as your candidate will be tired at the end of his/her weekend. **NOTE**: If you are on the team and sponsoring a candidate, arrange for someone to drive your candidate to and from the weekend.
- Make yourself available to your candidate's family for church, shopping, meals, babysitting, or any other personal need that may arise. If your candidate has few or no outside needs, be sure to be there to help during the weekend. There is always a need for help!
- After the weekend, accompany your candidate to the post-Cursillo seminar and to Ultreya.
- Be available to answer any and all question regarding the Cursillo Movement that your candidate may have. There are excellent brochures available to help you in this matter. Contact the Lay Director for a copy if your parish does not have one.
- Help your candidate utilize the Cursillo tools to persevere in his/her environment.

### From Bishop David J. Bonnar's Pastoral Letter:

## "Testify to the Light"




"Testify to the Light" was Bishop Bonnar's first Pastoral Letter to the Youngstown Diocese. It was published February 2021. One of the sections speaks to the importance of Small Groups, which is the essence of what the Cursillo Movement was founded upon and continues to do to this day.

Here are Bishop Bonnar's comments:

### The Formation of Small Groups

It is my dream that parishes will form small groups for people to share their faith and support one another as they become disciples. These small groups can be tailored to accommodate people's schedules and be made up of men, women, married couples and individuals. By coming together in a small venue, individuals can share their faith and encounter Jesus through the Gospel and in other ways enabling them to go forth and proclaim the Gospel. Small groups are a powerful way to accompany one another as pilgrims on the journey.

There is a difference between being a follower and a disciple. We need more disciples in the Church who like John the Baptist can boldly speak in the wilderness and be a witness to the light. Pope Francis says, "Missionary disciples accompany missionary disciples."
