
CURSILLO FOUNDER EDUARDO BONNIN

Cursillos in Christianity is a Movement which, by its own Method, attempts from within the Church, to give life to the essential Christian truths in the singularity, originality and creativity of the person. In discovering their potential and accepting their limitations, they will direct their freedom with their conviction, reinforce their will with decisiveness and direct their friendship with the virtue of constancy in their day-to-day life, personally and with others. Living their Piety, Study, and Action.

7. Bishop Cordes: What is the meaning of "to evangelize" today?

Eduardo Bonnín: In my view, this means the same thing in the past and the future. The Gospel does not change; it is up to us to change. The Gospel is always new and renews us. It is the means to live it that is changing. I see that the difficulty at present comes from the fact that man prefers what is immediate more than what is true, and this happens because the world is organized to prevent people from thinking or having time to think, to dominate them and manipulate them, and to propose anything to them, except to act as a person.

To evangelize a person is not only to speak about the Gospel, but it is necessary to place them in circumstances that will permit them to grasp Christ's message, and amid the complications of their life, they discover, under the light of faith, that the Gospel gives them the right orientation to use their freedom and be happier, a light by which to find the precise balance that gives them interior peace and constant encouragement to interpret the events of life, good and bad.


