A Message from our Spiritual Advisor—Father Edward Brienz



Dear Friends,

"Tempus Fugit!" is the Latin phrase for "Time Flies!", or perhaps more accurately, "Time Flees!" or even "Time Escapes!". We can't hold time in a bottle. Doesn't it feel as if we just had ashes imposed upon our foreheads, we just got used to meatless Fridays, just settled in to our added acts of piety, have our charitable intentions building, and still we

haven't had our fill (but can we ever get our fill?) of contemplative prayer. But... up comes Holy Week leading to the Sacred Triduum, and the basis for our entire understanding of God's love for Humanity: the Resurrection of Our Lord Jesus Christ! We must be deliberate in recognizing the mileposts of our faith journeys. We have no time to waste looking backwards, since the stone has been rolled away from the tomb of the past. Our invitation to eternal life is laid out before us. The liturgical cycles of the Church wisely guide us to appreciate these mysteries each year.

St. Augustine preached on the topic of Easter:

Turning then to the Lord our God, the Father Almighty, let us as best we can give thanks with all our hearts, beseeching Him that in His Goodness He will mercifully hear our prayers, and by His grace drive evil from our thoughts and actions, increase our faith, guide our minds, grant us His holy inspirations, and bring us to joy without end, through His Son our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. Amen.

I invite you to share your Easter joy with all those you encounter, and to encounter beyond our circle of convenience.


